THIS MONTH'S POLICY: **International Convention | Section 184.1 & 184.2**

Section 184.1

"The International House of Delegates allows two delegates from each club registered for the convention in addition to the International delegates at large. The persons selected by their clubs as delegates should be sure to register as delegates at the convention and participate in the discussion at the Caucuses and House of Delegates"

Summary: Two delegates are allowed per club and should register and attend the Caucus session and the House of Delegates.

Important: If you are a delegate, the delegate certification form must be filled out and signed by your club president and secretary! [It is available online here.](#)
BEE proactive and get this filled out!

Section 184.2

"Attendance will be taken at each Caucus session. Failure to attend more than one caucus session will be cause for investigation. If there is not a good reason for the absence(s), the Administrator/Tour leader shall write a letter to the sponsoring Kiwanis and Key Club specifying the failure of the Key Club member to act responsibly at Convention."

Summary: Do not skip out on your delegate duties! Your absence will be noted and reported.
