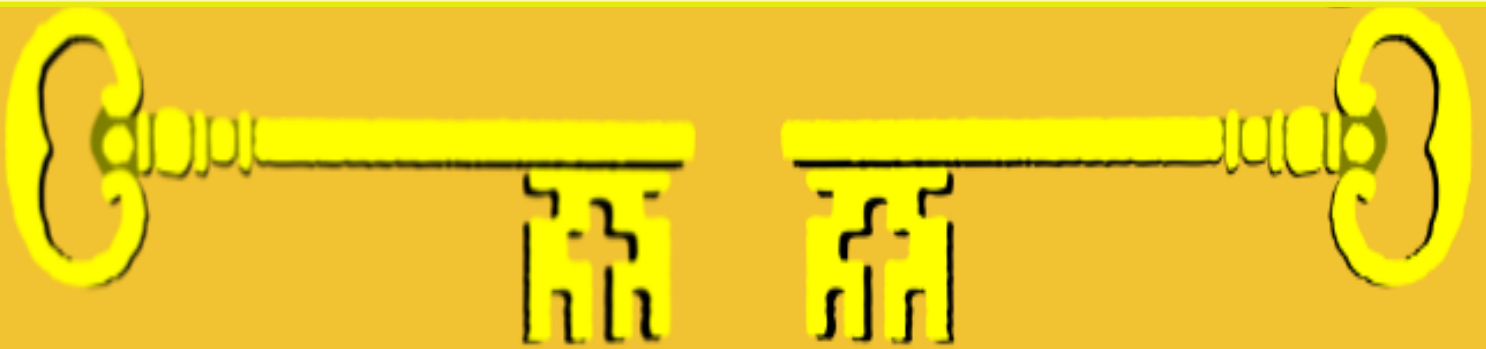

Region College Expo Coordinator Applications AVAILABLE NOW!

Are you interested in taking your leadership and communication skills to the next level? Want to become more involved in the planning of your region's RTC? Then consider applying to be a **Region College EXPO Coordinator**. Region College EXPO Coordinators will plan and organize a College EXPO at their respective Region Training Conference.

Region College EXPO Coordinators will be in charge of contacting all of the local colleges and universities, inviting them to their RTC's College EXPO, creating a layout of the booths, making a map outline of the room which will be included in the RTC's program, finding Kiwanians willing to showcase the CNH Foundation Scholarship, and other miscellaneous tasks. A directives sheet will be sent to all the RCECs once they have been appointed, and I will be providing each of them with tips on how to successfully plan their Region College EXPO. My hope is that serving as a Region College EXPO Coordinator will not only inspire more of you to consider applying for the District CEC position next term, but also give you experience in planning a College EXPO. One RCEC will be appointed per region unless the Lieutenant Governors request two. You can apply to be an RCEC

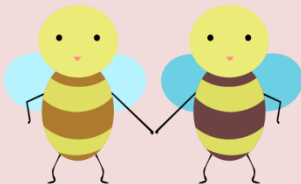

Eligibility:

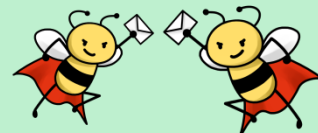
- Be between the ages of 16 and 21 on June 30, 2015
