1. The Club Poster contest is an international contest. Eligible submissions must first be submitted to the CNH Key Club District Member Recognition Office at DCON 2018 for judging on the District level. At District Convention 2018, distinguished contest poster winners will be announced, but only the first and second place submissions will go on to compete on the International level at ICON 2018.
2. Read the Club Poster contest guidelines.
3. Fill out the "Club Poster Contest Entry Form" and provide it at the beginning of the submission.
4. Turn in the submission to the CNH Key Club District Member Recognition Office at DCON. Submissions must be **received** by Friday, April 13th, 2018 by 6:00PM.

CLUB POSTER GUIDELINES

RULES GOVERNING THE KEY CLUB INTERNATIONAL CLUB POSTER AWARD

The Club Poster award shall provide recognition to Key Clubs that best demonstrate the values of our organization via a poster.

- A. The Key Club International **Poster Contest** will be conducted according to the following rules.
- B. The first and second place Key Club Poster contest winners from the California-Nevada-Hawaii Key Club district will be eligible to compete in the International contest.
- C. The poster should be designed to effectively recruit new members for Key Club and should not bear the name of any school, community, or district.
- D. **NON-DIGITAL:** Entries in this category may not include material produced through electronic means, such as cameras and computer software.
- E. **DIGITAL:** Entries in this category may include material produced through electronic means, such as cameras and computer software.
- F. The poster dimensions should be 18 inches by 24 inches with the actual height and width, after adding designs, not varying more than one-half inch for the prescribed contest dimensions. The poster should not measure more than one-eighth (1/8) inch in thickness after added designs.
- G. The following information must be submitted with each entry.
 1. Name of the Key Club, Division, Region, and District.
 2. Contact name and information for the artist

- producing the poster. The artist must be a Key Club member.
- H. Posters will be judged according to the following criteria:

 - I. Suitable awards will be presented.
 - J. Winning entries will become the property of Key Club International and will NOT be returned to clubs. Key Club International reserves the right to reproduce any contest winners, providing appropriate credit to the Key Club and artist.
 - K. All entries shall be in good taste and appropriate to the standards set by the Objects of Key Club International.
 - L. The decision of the judges is final and there will be allowed no changes, alterations, or re-judging (cut out will take place) after the judges and the Chair of Member Recognition have certified the results.

FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

1. What do I do if I want to revise my submission but it has already been turned in?

Remember to look over your submission very carefully before submitting it to the MR Office. No revisions may be made after it has been submitted.

2. Can you clarify what it means to provide the “Club Poster Contest Entry Form” at the beginning of the submission?

Simply place the filled out and printed “Club Poster Contest Entry Form” at the front of the submission, then package the submission accordingly, and send it out to the recipient.

3. Does having items or material attached to the poster add to the overall thickness limit?

Yes, your poster should not measure more than one-eighth (1/8) inch in thickness.

4. What does "Artistic Ability" mean for the judging criteria?

Artistic Ability is how aesthetically pleasing and eye-catching the poster is. The poster submission should look well put together, attractive, and follow the Key Club graphic standards.

5. Am I allowed to submit a copy of my work to the recipient, and keep the original for myself?

Please turn in the original work to the recipient. You may produce a copy for yourself to keep before sending it in.

6. Will the CNH District winner of this contest be recognized at DCON?

Yes, the winner of this contest will be recognized at District Convention 2018.

7. How do I qualify for the International level contest?

Eligible submissions must first be submitted to the CNH Key Club District for judging on the District level. At District Convention 2018, only the first and second place district winners will be eligible to compete in the international contest.

8. Do the two district winners have to place their entry for the International competition?

The first and second place winners of the CNH District for this contest do not have to place their entry for the International competition, but it is highly encouraged that you do so. Once an individual has entered the district level competition, it displays their dedication and commitment to entering the International contest, for 1) the honor of being recognized on the International level and 2) representing CNH in this contest at ICON 2018.

11. Do you have to be present at DCON or ICON for your entry to win this contest?

It is recommended to be present at DCON or ICON; however, you do not need to be present. In the event your submission wins, the award will be given to a representative from your home club/division.
