K-Kids

Kiwanis Kids (K-Kids) is a student led organization for elementary students with the motto, "we build".

You can...

- Co-Sponsor a K-Kids with your sponsoring Kiwanis Club
- Lead a service project — planting trees
- Host a spooky Halloween storytelling event with the K-Kids

Builders Club

Builders Club is the middle school branch of the Kiwanis Family with the motto, "Building Leaders".

You can...

- Speak at their assembly (w/ school principal's permission) about Key Club & reach out to those 14 years & up about Key Leader and seeking out local Kiwanis for scholarships
- Collaborate with them on service projects: campus cleanups or creating friendship bracelet kits

KIWIN'S

KIWIN'S is a student led organization for high school students, similar to Key Club, with the motto, "One Family. One Mission. One Word: KIWIN'S".

You can...

- Do a beach /canyon clean-up together and/or assist your sponsoring Kiwanis with their service projects — pancake breakfasts or spaghetti dinner
- Ensure that your local KIWIN'S know how to reach out to Kiwanis for scholarships for Key Leader

Circle K

Circle K is the premier college and university community service, leadership development, and friendship organization with the motto, "Live to Serve, Love to Serve".

You can...

- Reach out to your local Circle K and attend their Key 2 College
- Bring the Kiwanis Shadow Program, in which a Circle K member would mentor a Key Club member
- Collaborate with your local Circle K on a service project

Aktion Club

Aktion Club is the only service club for adults with disabilities with the motto, "Where development has no disability".
