EVENT IDEAS

FUNDRAISER IDEAS

Sell Bottles & Cans



Collect plastic bottles and aluminum cans by setting up bins in classrooms or having members go around and pick them up to further promote cleanliness in your communities. Take those bottles and cans and sell them at a recycling center. You can donate the proceeds to a charity of choice!

Recycled Art



BEE creative and have members make art out of recycled material or upcycle old items and hold an exhibit showcasing the art. Your club can sell concessions or ask for donations in exchange for art pieces. You can even partner with the art or photography club. Then donate the proceeds!

Partner with Companies



Just like a restaurant fundraiser, your club can partner with an eco-friendly company to raise funds to donate or for your club to host a big event. Some examples include reusable bag companies, Plymouth greeting cards, the Fair Trade Company, and more!
