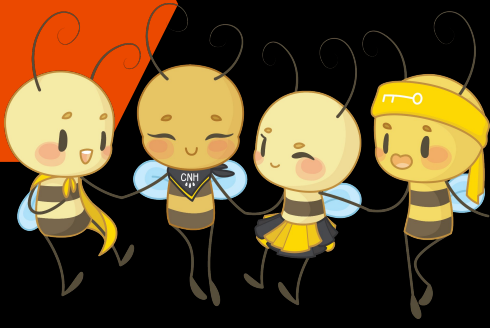

WHAT IS THE SOSP?

The CNH Spotlight on Service Program is a district project that promotes different District and International initiatives every month. The Service Project Committee provides monthly guides that include information and tips on how clubs can complete the monthly service initiatives. This program enables clubs to showcase their unique service projects and even have the chance to receive recognition on the District Newsletter.

HOW TO SUBMIT

In order to receive recognition, clubs can submit on the SOSP form, which can be found under the “Spotlight on Service Program” page under the “Projects” tab on the CNH CyberKey or at tinyurl.com/SubmitSOSP. All submissions are due on the fifth of the following month by **6:00 PM (PST)** or **3:00 PM (HST)**. One or more clubs are featured every month in the District Newsletter in recognition of any outstanding service project!

UNICEF Awareness

Create flyers about UNICEF and share it with people you know and your local community. You can create digital flyers or physical ones. The flyers can be used to educate people about what UNICEF does. They can include their specific programs, why you should donate to them, and more.

Make Hand Warmers

October is around the time when it starts cooling down a lot and people can get frostbite (especially in their fingers!). Help keep hands warm by making hand warmers! You will need: fabric (you can make it Halloween themed!), rice, thread, sewing needles, and scissors. Use this link to learn how to do this project: [Hand Warmer Sewing Tutorial](#)

Make Candy Bags With Kids

Partner with a local youth organization or elementary school to help kids decorate bags to hold their candy. You can have them supply their own bag or pillowcase to decorate or your club can provide the bags (canvas bags can come cheap if you purchase them in bulk!). Have Key Clubbers facilitate the decorating and have them assist the kids when needed.

Host a Pumpkin Carving Contest

A great way to engage with your community and to raise awareness for UNICEF is to host a pumpkin carving contest. Have an entrance fee for participants that can go towards donations for UNICEF.

Sell Halloween Grams

Halloween grams are a piece of candy with a message attached to it. People purchase them and have them delivered to people they know. Have a table set up at your school so people can purchase the Halloween Grams. Then, as Halloween approaches recruit some Key Clubbers to pass them out

Host a Halloween Movie Night

Get a room at your school or another location in your community and host a Halloween movie night. Collect entrance fees and sell food and drinks to raise money to be donated to UNICEF. Have fun with it and decorate the room to be Halloween themed or have people come in their costumes!

Trick or Treat for UNICEF

Trick or Treat for UNICEF is something Key Club has been doing for UNICEF for years. Go around neighborhoods and collect donations for UNICEF.

You can order cardboard boxes from UNICEF to collect the donations. You can also ask your local Kiwanis clubs for donations.

Host a Drive-Through Trick or Treat

Partner with a local youth organization or an elementary school to host a drive-through trick or treat! Have Key Clubbers make goody bags for kids and have them passed out. You can also make small informational cards about UNICEF and include those in the goody bags.

Host a Haunted House

This is a great way to raise a lot of money and earn a lot of service hours at the same time! You will need a lot of help from people to be actors, run registration, and to make sure it goes smoothly. Work with your school or Kiwanians to try to get a location to minimize extra costs so more money can be donated to UNICEF.
