The March of Dimes works to raise awareness of prematurity and to reduce the rate of premature births. Key Club has been service partners with the March of Dlmes since 1978 and has continued to work together to innovate new awareness and fundraising activities.

### **importance**

Preterm birth is one that occurs before the 37th week of pregnancy. 1 in every 8 babies born in the United States is born premature. Birth defects are the leading cause of death in the first year of life. Through research, community services, education, and advocacy, the March of Dimes hopes to improve the overall health of babies.



# personal statement

"Everybody goes through a lot in this life," she says. "To get my story out right now is very important—to share with women who have premature babies because it's a very devastating feeling to not know if your baby is going to survive"... #### • Raise funds through March for Babies

- Put together your own team of club members and community volunteers, collect pledges in support, and participate in the annual March for Babies Walks that take place every Spring
- Contact your local newborn intensive care unit (NICU)
  - Club members are invited to participate in **NICU** tours (where available) and to learn about ways to get more involved
- Invite a speaker to a club meeting
  - Increase community awareness by welcoming a health professional, researcher, or mission family to speak about how March of Dlmes has changed their lives











United Nations International Children's Emergency Fund (**UNICEF**) was created in 1946. They advocate, fundraise, and educate for the survival, protection and development of children. UNICEF is one of the most recognizable children's organization worldwide.

   sexual violence annually
- Approximately 73 million children work jobs that put their health, safety, moral development and lives at risk
- An estimated 650 million girls and women today were married before their 18th birthday

Through service projects, the mission of the Pediatric Trauma Program (PTP) is to reduce the number of children in CNH who are killed or injured by trauma. The goal is to ensure **all children live happy, healthy and safe lives**.

PTP is not a preferred charity but is heavily emphasized in our CNH district.

# **importance**

- Pediatric Trauma is the leading cause of death and injury among children ages 14 and under in the United States
- Unintentional injury kills more kids every year than any other cause
- 8,000 families lose a child because of a preventable injury annually in the U.S.
- 90% of unintentional injuries are preventable

The Eliminate Project is an initiative designed to assist in the **elimination of Maternal and Neonatal Tetanus** globally, which is a disease that is the result of the release of toxins from Clostridium tetani bacteria. This disease has no cure, and it has an extremely devastating impact on those living particularly in Africa, where it claims the lives of approximately 110,000 people per year.

#### **importance**

- Newborn babies who have contracted MNT have a life expectancy of around 7 days, highlighting the urgency of protecting children around the globe from MNT
